

Stay on Top of Your Game with the Pipeline

As a sales professional, you need a clear view of your performance on a continuing basis. Also, it is well known that an organized sales rep is a better sales rep- this can distinguish you from the competition. JOBZ! makes it easy to accomplish both goals. It's all about the Pipeline.

It's as easy as 1, 2, 3:

1) On a daily basis, use the ORGANIZE pull-down sorts in JOBZ! to help keep yourself organized, especially the Pending and Working sorts.

JOBZ! will automatically update a job's Status when you send a Proposal (from In Estimating to Pending), when you turn in an SOP (from Pending to Working) and when you output an Invoice Draft (from Working to Billed), so most of the organizing is already done for you. However, once a job has moved to Pending or Working Status, you need to pay attention.

The Pending and Working job sorts will actually help identify jobs that need your attention. When the Invoice Date drifts into the past, JOBZ! will remind you to correct it, or to change the status. Only after you make the corrections will you be shown the complete list of jobs you have in those Status categories. If a job is still Pending then it logically should have an Invoice Date in the future, right? Or if it has gone away, then change the Status to Dead. If it appears in Working, but has an Invoice Date in the past, then it probably should be in the Status of either Shipped or Billed (or else have the anticipated Invoice Date adjusted).

For another thing, if you make use of the Follow Up Date when you quote a job, you can keep an eye on when you need to follow up on quotes you have placed. Just click the Follow Up button on the Pending list.

2) Run your own Pipeline report. This will give you an overview of what the current month and near future are looking like.

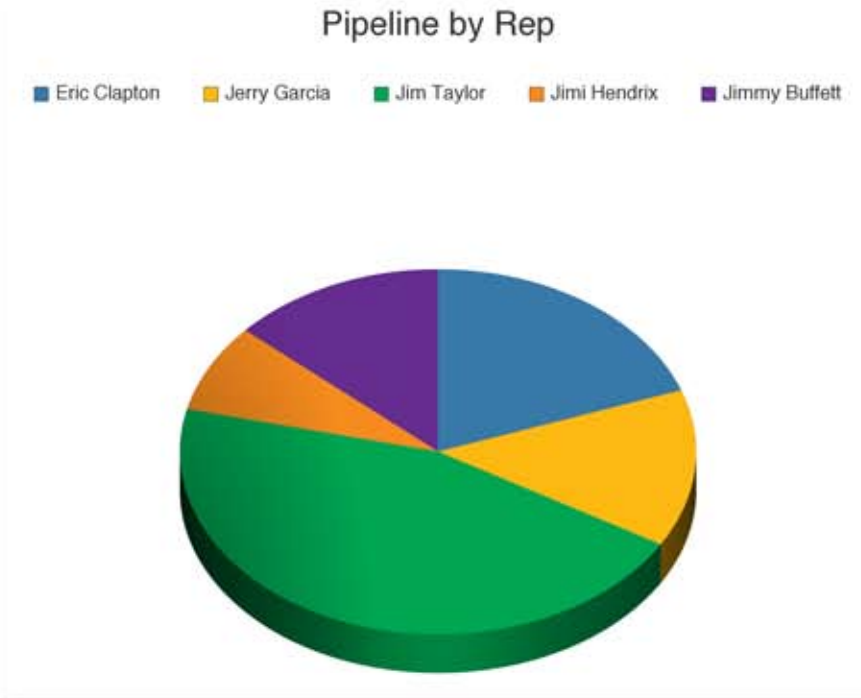

Keep notes to yourself about a job.	

You are prompted when emailing proposals to add the job to your Pipeline. Just do it! You can also do it on the QUOTE screen, Tracking box. This is also where you can set a Follow Up Date. Keep your Pending jobs current as to Invoice Date and Likelihood of sale. (If a job is just a variation or alternate version, it does not need to be in the Pipeline. Pick one of the variations to include in your Pipeline.) The % of likelihood will be applied to the average price of all the quantities you are quoting.

3) When a job ships out, or is billed, change the job's status and invoice date accordingly.

Again, JOBZ! will automatically change the Status to Billed when you produce an Invoice Draft. You will now have an accurate record of your billed sales. Running the Working sort will help identify which jobs should be ready to invoice, based on the Invoice Date slipping into the past.

That's it! Use these features to stay on top of your game. And incidentally, when a Manager runs the Pipeline, it will include your Pipeline. Just sayin'...
